



c l e a n i n g & c a r e Treat surface with care. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.

A Phillips head screwdriver is necessary for assembly.



4.	OPEN WRENCH		1 PC

- 1. Place table top (A) upside down on a non-abrasive surface such as carpet (underside of tabletop should be facing up).
- 2. Attach the legs (B) to the apron of table top (A) using 8 flat washers (1), 8 spring washers (2), and 8 nuts (3) as shown.






3. Turn the table upright. Make sure the table is level, and tightly fasten all nuts (3) using the open-end wrench (4) as shown.

The table is now ready for use




C. CHAIR BACK 4 PCS



1.	FLAT WASHER	0	4 PCS	
2.	SPRING WASHER	0	4 PCS	
3.	NUT	(a)	4 PCS	
4.	OPEN WRENCH	5	1 PC	

1. Attach 2 front legs (E) to seat frame (D) using 4 nuts (3), 4 spring washers (2), and 4 flat washers (1) as shown.

Note: The seat frame (D) has 2 holes on each side, which are used to attach the seat. These holes are wider on the bottom and narrower on the top. Ensure the wider holes are facing towards you.



1.	FLAT WASHER	0	7 PCS
2.	SPRING WASHER	0	7 PCS
4.	OPEN WRENCH	5	1 PC
5.	SHORT BOLT	0	3 PCS
6.	LONG BOLT	0	4 PCS

- 2. Attach the seat frame (D) to the chair back (C) using 3 short bolts (5), 4 long bolts (6), 7 spring washers (2), and 7 flat washers (1) as shown. Do not fully tighten.
- 3. Turn the chair upright. Make sure the assembled chair unit is level and square. Tightly fasten all nuts (3) and bolts (5&6) with the open-end wrench (4).

4. Place cushion seat (F) upside down on a non-abrasive table surface. The rear (tapered end) of the cushion seat (F) should be near the table edge.

Hint: Protect the non-abrasive table surface and cushion seat (F) by laying a towel in-between the chair seat and table.

5. Place the assembled chair frame on the cushion seat (F) as shown. Attach with 6 wood screws (7). Tighten the screws.


Turn the chair upright.

6. Repeat diagram #3 to #6 to assemble the other chairs.




DIAGRAM #7



1. Attach 2 side panels (K) to seat frame (H) and side crossbars (L) as shown.

Note: The seat frame (I) has 4 holes on each long side, which are used to attach the seat cushion. These holes are wider on the bottom and narrower on the top. Ensure the wider holes are facing towards you. The side panel has different top and bottom joining points. Ensure the joining points are perfectly match with seat frame and side crossbars.



2. Attach bench legs (I & J) to seat frame (D) and side crossbars (L) using 8 flat washers (1), 8 spring washers (2), and 8 nuts (3) as shown. Screw 4 wood screws (7) to secure the crossbars (L).

Note: The bench leg has hole on its inner side to attach the crossbars. Make sure the holes facing toward the crossbars.


3. Place cushion seat (G) upside down on a non-abrasive surface.

Hint: Protect the non-abrasive table surface and cushion seat (F) by laying a towel in-between the chair seat and table.

4. Place the assembled bench frame on the cushion seat (G) as shown. Attach with 8 wood screws (7). Tighten the screws.
